
Congratulations! The food drive is going well! We have achieved the goal for our matching donation and it has been received. Please keep the momentum going as we continue to collect food through November 18th.


Sunday, November 25 is Hanging of the Greens. We need everyone to please stay after church to help decorate the sanctuary.
